

MINUTES Meeting 25th January 1993 ASSINGTON PARISH COUNCIL (3)

7. **OTHER MATTERS etc.**

Free Butter/Beef - Assington appeared to have missed out. Leavenheath had allocation which stemmed from Nayland and Clerk had learned from A Boreham that Nayland delivery represented Leavenheath, Stoke & Nayland only & Assington would be with Bures. Bures PC however had not had a hand out. Initial distribution is via Royal British Legion. Clerk had spoken with Bures rep. (Major Eaton) who had handed out small allocation to Bures O.A.Ps. Strictly only people who qualify are those classified as 'destitute' i.e. on Income Support, Disability living allowance. For future Major Eaton should liaise with RBL Assington rep. Mrs Jean Heseltine. Clerk to speak to Mrs Heseltine.

Bures Road (Dows Hill section) Mr N Miller mentioned accidents had occurred & felt it important that in icy weather this area be gritted. Additionally the PC considered 'Road Narrow' signs appropriate each end to warn motorists to slow down & drive carefully through this narrow section. Clerk to approach SCC/Highways accordingly. 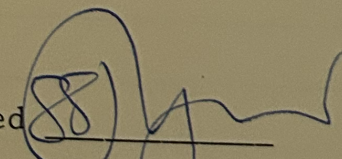
