

MINUTES Meeting 24th January 1994 ASSINGTON Parish Council cont/d...(2)

92/93 AUDIT This was to be at Council Offices/Hadleigh 10.00am 16 February 1994. Appropriate notices had been posted in the village.

PARISH PRECEPT 1994/95 BDC advised Tax Base for Parish to be 163.52 i.e. no of Band D equivalents after allowing for discounts etc. On £1850 precept requested for 94/95 equated to £11.31/household.

JG mentioned **Playground Equipment**.

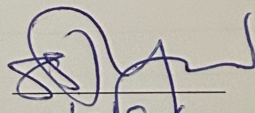
Both topics would be included on the agenda for the Parish Meeting.

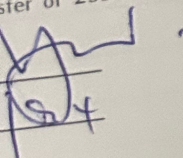
