

MINUTES Meeting 29th March 1993 ASSINGTON PARISH COUNCIL (2)

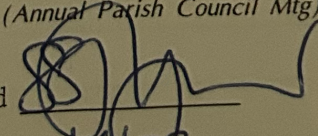
- h) **PATH CARE** This item was deferred to the next meeting.
2. **NEW VILLAGE HALL** Update covered in Annual Parish Meeting which followed.
3. **STREET NAMEPLATES** BDC by letter (24/2) had advised that Mr Wilson of Springfield Autos had reported no street nameplates were in existence for Barracks Road or Marshalls Green & Sudbury/Colchester Road. The PC's comments on this suggestion would thus be welcomed in addition had therefore requested nameplates be erected to identify the road for the benefit of traffic on the to the correct name for the Barracks area since it was understood this road was known by at least 4 names or variations of the name 'Barrack'. The PC had no objection to such nameplates & it was decided that a long standing Assington resident should be approached in order to ascertain the correct name for Barracks Road.
4. **DONATION** The PC authorised the following expenditure under Section 137 - a donation of £20.00 to Suffolk Accident Rescue Service (pr. CH, scd GD).
5. The Clerk reported on **PLANNING - 22 THE STREET/LBC ERECTION FRONT PORCH**. Notification (25/1/93) had been received from the D.O.E. that the appeal for the Porch had been dismissed, replacement windows had been allowed.
- 15 **THE STREET/LBC REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING PEG TILES WITH SLATES**. Returned 30/1/93 - the Planning Committee had objected. **PERMISSION REFUSED 17/2/93**.
- ROSE GREEN/MRS J JONES ERECTION OF FIRST FLOOR SIDE EXTENSION**. Received 2/2/93, returned 15/2/93. (The Clerk declared interest in same). Plan submitted with the application was not accurate & the planning committee had commented on roof height not being continuous & windows expressing concern that the scale & form of the property as whole should not be distorted by the proposal. **PERMISSION GRANTED 3/3/93**. Mrs S Carman by letter 11/3 had explained the reasoning for same.
- DILLACKS FARM/CONVERSION OF BARN & OUTBUILDINGS TO DWELLING & CONSTRUCTION OF VEHICULAR ACCESS** received 18/2/93, returned 15/3/93 PC APPROVED.
- DILLACKS FARM/LBC INTERNAL & EXTERNAL ALTERATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH CONVERSION OF BARN & OUTBLDGS TO ONE DWELLING** Received 1/3/93, returned 15/3/93 PC APPROVED.
- GLEBE HOUSE BARN/CHANGE OF USE REDUNDANT BARN & BYRE to ANTIQUES SHOP & ANCILLARY ACCOMMODATION** Received 29/3/93. IN CIRCULATION.
- FINANCE** BPA **CREDIT** balance of £1522, CURRENT a/c **CREDIT** balance of £107. Payments to EE (£85), VPMC annual a/c booking fees for PC mtgs (£48), Clerks salary/expenses to 31/3 (£108) & annual subscription to SALC (£53) were approved, together with the transfer of £350 from BPA to current a/c.

Letter 1/3/93 Village of the Year Competition 1993, letter 2/3/93 from David Houchell offering Bldg Design & Planning Consultancy Service, letter 2/3/93 Guidance Note 7 - An Approach to the Design of New Housing in Babergh, letter SCC 3/3/93 National Environment Week May 22-31. Feb '93 1993 Register of Electors (305 listed for Assington), BDC Annual Report & Accounts 1991-2, Suffolk Scene (ACRE) Spring 1993, NALC Annual Report & Accounts 1991-2, The Shire Spring 1993, Booklet (Suffolk ASH) Action on Smoking & Health 'A Discussion Guide for Parish Councils', Local Council Review Winter 1992, Sudbury & District Volunteer Centre Newsletter March 1993, Leaflet SCC Civic Amenity Sites for the Deposit of Household Waste, BDC Budget 1993-94 (Report).
